

All4Zero, awarded at the go!ODS Awards of the UN Global Compact Spain

- **The industrial technology innovation hub has been awarded in the category 'SDG 17. Partnerships to achieve the Goals', for its commitment to jointly contribute to sustainable development.**

Madrid, February 23, 2024 - All4Zero, the industrial technological innovation hub founded by [ArcelorMittal](#), [Holcim](#), [Iberia](#) and [Repsol](#), has been awarded in the IV Edition of the go!ODS Awards, organized and managed by the [UN Global Compact Spain](#), an entity that leads business sustainability in the world, in collaboration with the [Rafael del Pino Foundation](#).

The purpose of these awards is to recognize and support innovative projects that contribute to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. In this IV edition, these awards have broken the record of participation, with a total of 506 nominations submitted in the 17 categories, doubling the number compared to previous editions.

In this fourth edition, **All4Zero** has been recognized in the category '**SDG 17. Partnerships to achieve the Goals**', for its commitment to contribute to sustainable development through collaborative and joint work. The hub was chosen from a total of 59 nominations submitted in this category.

"This alliance was born out of humility, as we are aware that working alone we will not be able to achieve the decarbonization targets set in the Paris Agreements. The hub arises from the need to drive the development and scaling of industrial technologies that contribute to the transformation of the different industrial sectors towards a more sustainable model, aimed at achieving net zero emissions by 2050," says Gema García, president of **All4Zero** and director of Open Innovation and Corporate Venturing at Repsol. "It is an honor and a source of pride to have received this award. This award not only validates our efforts, but also encourages us to move forward, involving more and more agents who share our strategic vision," she adds.

Collaboration between organizations is one of the key aspects recognized by these awards. In this sense, the hub has just announced the incorporation of new partners and collaborators to work together in the decarbonization of the industry. In total, since the launch of the hub last September, **12 partners and collaborators have already joined the initiative** and will bring together experts and industrial facilities to make more agile progress towards achieving the goal of decarbonizing industry.

All4Zero has also recently launched its first **technological challenges** related to CO2 capture and use, mineralization, renewable hydrogen production, efficient management of water resources, waste recovery, sustainable fuels for aviation and other renewable fuels. This public call, aimed at startups, technology centers, research teams, universities and SMEs, seeks technological solutions for the

decarbonization of industry. The applications will be evaluated by teams of **All4Zero** scientists and experts, who will select **up to ten solutions to develop proof-of-concepts in the hub members' industrial centers**.

The hub partners, together with Mariano Garcia, Sustainability Director of Holcim España and Vice President of All4Zero; Nacho Tovar, Director of Innovation and Digital Transformation of Iberia, and Gema García, Director of Open Innovation and Corporate Venturing of Repsol, and President of **All4Zero**, received the recognition at a gala event held at the Rafael del Pino Auditorium in Madrid.
